**"Quiet Quitting"**

*Are you familiar with the term "Quiet Quitting?" Have you ever heard it before? It is a relatively new expression in the office workplace. "Quiet quitting is an application of work-to-rule, in which employees work within defined activities and engage solely in activities within those hours. The philosophy of quiet quitting, despite the name, is not necessarily connected to quitting a job outright, but rather doing exactly what the job requires." "The term "quiet quitting" has different shades of meaning depending on the source. While individual contributors might think in terms of otherwise "engaged workers setting reasonable boundaries", their employers might see them instead as 'slackers who are willfully under-performing'."*

*However, "Quiet Quitting" is really nothing new. Folks have been "Quiet Quitting." church for many years.*

*They first quit God. They stop praying. They stop reading their Bibles. Then at some point, they stop attending one service at a time. It is based on which of the four times seems to be inconvenient for their work, family, or entertainment.*

*The writer of Hebrews knew the problem all too well. He wrote, "Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as the manner of some is," (Hebrews 10:25a). Fourteen verses later, He wrote, "for we are not of them who draw back," (Hebrews 10:39a). The prophet Jeremiah was plain spoken, he would have called in backsliding. "Turn O, backsliding children," and a few verses later, "Return ye backsliding children," (Jeremiah 3:14 & 22).*

*No matter how much they are exhorted to pick-up the pace in attendance, they stay in their comfortable schedule. Finally, someone at church, some Sunday says, "I have not seen so-and-so in church for some time."*
