Here is an example of the daily habits of John Jay, First Chief Justice of the United States Supreme Court, 1789 – 1794. He was regular in his domestic habits. Every morning, immediately, before breakfast, the family, including the domestics, were summoned to prayers; and the call was repeated precisely at nine at night, when he read to them a chapter in the Bible, and concluded with prayer. At the close of the evening devotions, he retired to rest, except when courtesy to his guests induced him to keep later hours; but the presence of company neither postponed nor suspended the family worship.
