Pastor's Paragraphs

William Jessup judge of the the 11th Judicial District of Pennsylvania 1838 – 1851, put the Kingdom of God first. “In 1827, he was hopefully converted during a revival of religion which prevailed in the town of Montrose. For a whole week, he was under deep religious impression. An important case at law in which he was engaged, was at the time about to be tried at Wilkesbarre, and he sent word to the judge that the cause must be postponed or go on without him, as he was engaged in a cause before a higher than earthly tribunal, which must be settled before he could engage in business again. When at length he made the surrender and accepted Christ, his peace and joy were beyond expression.
